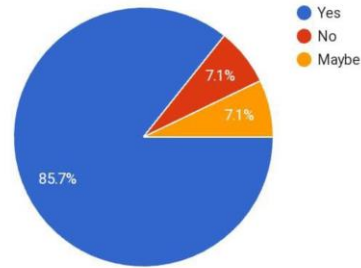
Rate the Email Writing Competition

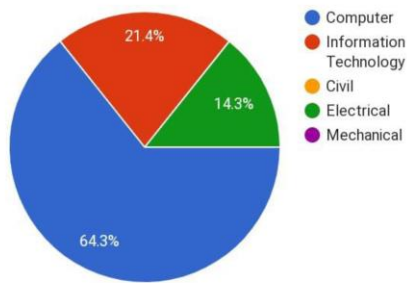

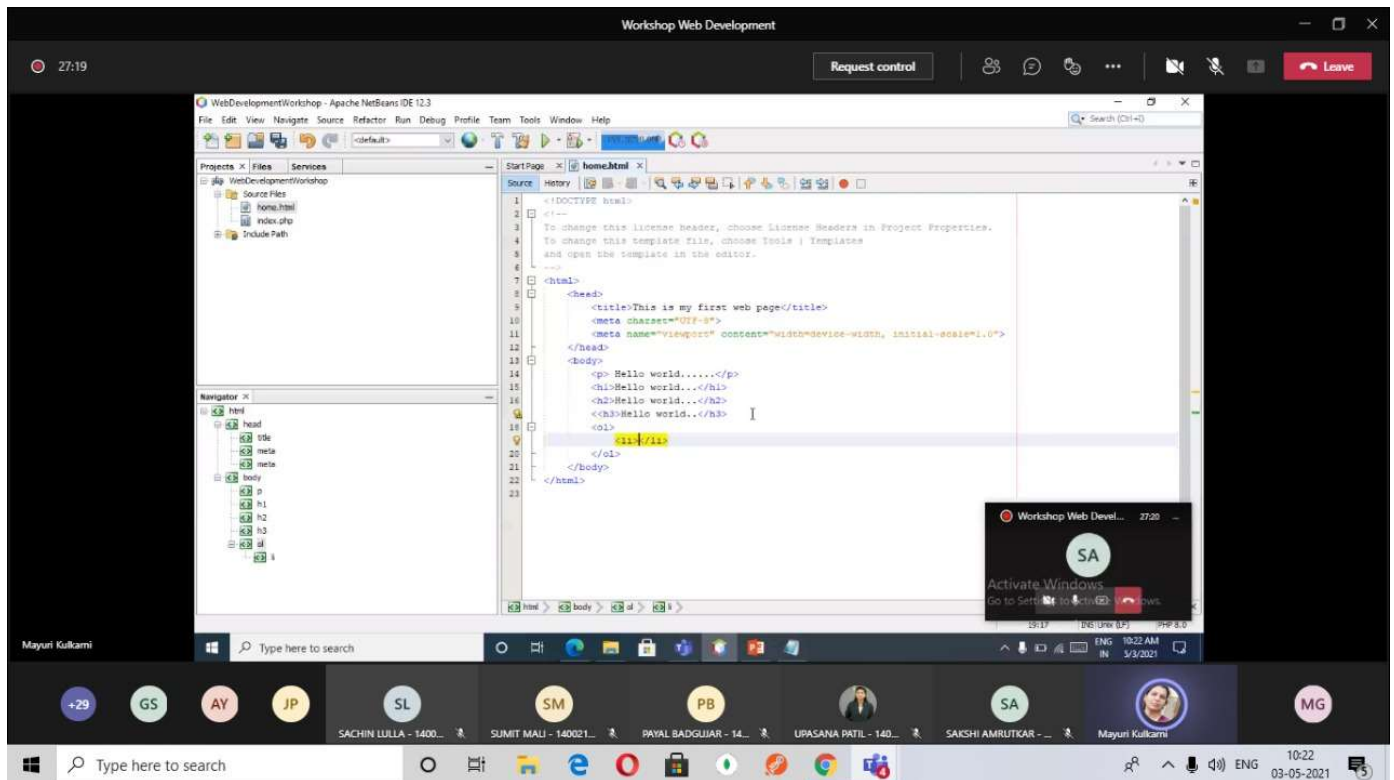

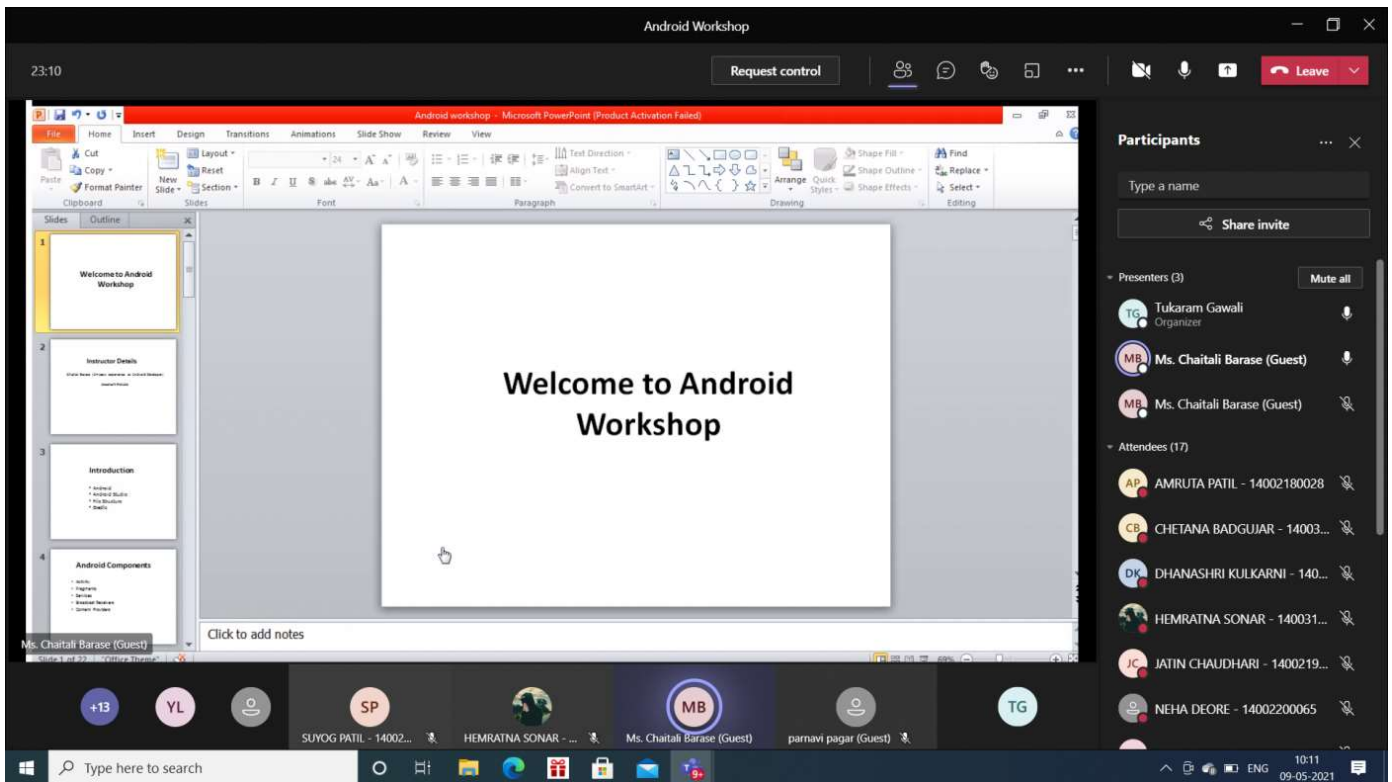
