EVENT REPORT



Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), SVKM's Institute of Technology Dhule, organized one-day expert talk on research grant proposal and patent writing on 30th-January-2023 at 10:00 am to 4:00 PM. For this expert, as a guest speaker, we have invited Dr. Bhaskar Idage, Ex. Scientist polymer science and engineering division, CSIR National Chemical laboratory Pune - MS, India.

Prof. Prerna Ikhar began the seminar by welcoming all participants and the guest speaker, as well as performing the traditional lamp lighting tradition. In addition, the webinar was handed over to Dr. Bhushan Chaudhari, IQAC Coordinator, SVKM's IoT Dhule, who presented a welcoming address and shared seminar objective with participants.

Resource Person, Dr. Bhaskar Idage have taken the session forward. In the first session, he discussed grant proposal writing and explained in general, a grant proposal includes a project concept, a justification of why the organisation wants grant funds, and proof proving the project's necessity and quality. He carried the session, how should a problem statement be written? This is the main section of our study proposal, and the literature review is very crucial. Similar to that, it was crucial while creating the patent. In a similar manner, it is crucial when developing project proposals. Further he continued his session about the essential ingredients of writing proposal. The first element is the issue. First, we must identify the issue, or the problems that our research will reveal. Then, based on those issues, we have to define a research proposal. Finally, Dr. Bhaskar Idage concluded his first session about the funding agencies in India that would support our research. The Department of Scientific and Technology (DST) is one of the financing organisations for engineering, science, and technology research in India that is run by the Indian government. We can write a proposal to the Department of Biotechnology. We can also submit a proposal to the Council for Industrial and Scientific Research (CSIR). Lastly session was added with question answer session. The guest speaker delivers his talk for more than 100 minutes followed by 15 minutes' question and answer. The expert talk was conducted in hybrid mode for which total 120 registrations count in which 84 students and 36 faculty members were joined this event. At the end of the expert talk, feedback link was share to participants and their received responses have attached below in chart format.

Prof. Datta Doifde began the second session in the afternoon by extending a warm welcome to all participants and guest speaker. Later, the guest speaker took over the seminar. He began the seminar on patent writing and drafting by saying that it is rather difficult to prepare a patent without knowing intellectual property rights and their many sorts. He continued the discussion by defining intellectual property and outlining the TRIPS trade related rights inspections. Then he talks about what is the WTO. After that, he discusses what intellectual property rights are, how they have evolved, how the International Convention by portfolio works, and so on. Furthermore, he covered the basics of thing repatent and what we must do. We must first draught a patent disclosure later, also known as a disclosure later, which must include at least three to four points. What makes this novel? What's the concept? And how at least one example will be used is sufficient to create a patent disclosure letter. Finally, he concluded the session on the IPR licensing and transfer of technology and

demonstrated different example of patent from the different countries i.e. US patent, Chinese patent. European patent, India patent. Lastly the session was ended with question answer session and vote of thanks by Dr. Shakeelur Raheman. The guest speaker delivers his talk for more than 120 minutes followed by 15 minutes' question and answer. The expert talk was conducted in hybrid mode for which total 130 registrations count in which 97 students and 33 faculty members were joined this event. At the end of the expert talk, feedback link was share to participants and their received responses have attached below in chart format.

- 2. Recognize the subjective parts of a grant proposal.


